

Joint Statement: Changes to Kiss myAsthma app

Dear asthma community,

We thank you for your continued support and use of Kiss myAsthma app. We're proud of the partnership we've formed with the University of Sydney to build and deliver this app over the years. Asthma Australia has now taken over the ownership and management of the app from the University.

Due to the significant age of the technology powering Kiss myAsthma, we will be removing the app from all stores whilst we spend time building a new interactive asthma support program, accessible from your smart phone. This will have the same functionality as you are currently using, and more.

However, due to these changes, we recommend recording your saved data elsewhere. You could do this by navigating to History in the app and scrolling down where you can change the number of days and screenshot your logbook over a specified time.

While we are building this revitalised and improved new digital asthma management offering, please use Asthma Australia's existing services, such as 1800 ASTHMA (1800 278 462). This is a dedicated line to Asthma Educators, who are trained to assist you in better understanding and managing asthma. We are grateful for your continued engagement.
