Primary purpose of the role

The Research Program Administrator is responsible for coordinating, managing, and supporting the activities and operations of Asthma Australia's research program. This position involves the management of stakeholder relationships and coordination of agreements related to funded research projects and partnerships, ensuring processes are progressive and compliant, facilitating collaboration among stakeholders, and providing administrative support to the research team. The Research Program Administrator plays a vital role in the success and efficiency of AA's research program by handling various administrative and organisational tasks.

 - Plan meetings for the year (x4)
 - o Coordinate, prepare and disseminate agenda and pre-reading
 - Compile and circulate minutes for each meeting
- Support evaluation and reflection processes
